Cost: \$420 per room with double occupancy (two beds) – A \$100 deposit check to Club Crabtowne Inc. will hold a spot until 10 rooms are filled. With a roommate you can share the cost. The trip is open to Crabtowne or other BRSC members only.

The full payment is needed by April 18 to lock in rooms; extra rooms may be possible if full payment is made by April 18 – as Cape May is popular. First to pay in full are the first to lock in one of the ten rooms. Amenities include: beachside, outdoor pool, a reserved parking spot per room, elevator, room kitchenette and A/C, shuffleboard, and sundeck

Cape May Weekend

Bikes: You can bring your own. Bikes can be locked on the back of your car on its rack or on the bike rack in the back of the hotel. Also, you can rent a bike nearby, e.g., Shields' bike rental (609) 898-1818 on Gurney St..

Bike ride: Begins at 10:00 a.m. and meets in the front. Shorter rides around town are on your own.

Extra Night: You may request an extra night. Might help to mention you are with the ski group. Ask for reservations when you call.

Ferry: From Lewes, DE to Cape May, NJ - cost about \$45.00 one-way. Call for reservations. (You can drive north of Baltimore into NJ and south in NJ to Cape May.) If the weather turns bad, you have to drive around, because ferries don't run in severe weather. You can also leave your car in Lewes, DE and just take your bike and suitcase aboard the ferry--about \$10.00 each way. Then you can ride from the ferry to the hotel on your bike (about a 20-minute easy ride). If possible, have a friend place your suitcase in his/her car for transport to the hotel. Beach: There is a small charge to go onto a beach in NJ: about \$7.00 for the weekend--a left out of the hotel.

Shopping: There are stores up and down the boardwalk at the beach, a left out of the hotel--about 3 short blocks away. There is also an outdoor walking mall, a right out of the hotel--about 4 blocks away. And there are many antique shops, all within biking or driving distance. Plus, there's a popular wicker outlet.

Night life: On the boardwalk, there are bars and hotel bars, with and without music. And there is always Wildwood (the amusement park).

Tours: Pay at the Walking Mall - Trolley Tours, Horse Drawn Carriage Rides, Dr. Physick Estate Tour, High Tea at the Physick Estate, Tour of some Victorian Homes, etc. (Costs vary.)
